2018 GOP PRIMARY ELECTION

December 2017

Survey conducted December 30 through December 31, 2017. 1,423 likely 2018 Republican Primary Election voters participated in the survey. Survey weighted to match expected turnout demographics for the 2018 Republican Primary Election. Margin of Error is +/-2.6% with a 95% level of confidence. Totals do not always equal 100% due to rounding.



Q1: What is your opinion of Donald Trump?

Favorable: 84% Unfavorable: 12% No opinion: 4%

Q2: What is your opinion of Ron DeSantis?

Favorable: 32% Unfavorable: 7% No opinion: 61%

Q3: What is your opinion of Richard Corcoran?

Favorable: 8% Unfavorable: 13% No opinion: 79%

Q4: What is your opinion of Adam Putnam?

Favorable: 37% Unfavorable: 6% No opinion: 57%

Q5: Possible candidates in the 2018 Republican Primary Election for Governor of Florida are Ron DeSantis, Adam Putnam and Richard Corcoran. If the election were held today, for whom would you vote?

Ron DeSantis: 28% Adam Putnam: 25% Richard Corcoran: 3% Undecided: 44%

Ron DeSantis: 30% Adam Putnam: 29% Undecided: 41%
