

I do hereby state that I am instituting this prosecution in good faith.

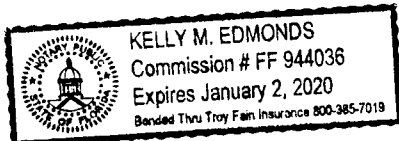
